


Cumulative Recruitment



Barts BioResource cumulative recruitment


Total consent N = 16621; Total re-consent N = 1027






Proportion of recruitment by researcher






Recruitment to sub-studies








Recruitment to each stratum




Recruitment trend of consent types



Proportion of biosamples collected









Location of patient recruitment






Trends in recruitment locations






Proportion of patients consenting to future contact









Proportion of patients consenting to future contact via email














Overview of May patients in the Cardiac Imaging Department

Number of patients consented versus patients refusing during May in the Cardiac Imaging Department






Chart showing number of patients out of hours in May in the Cardiac Imaging Department
